

JARRAHDALE TWO DAY WEEKEND TREK 2010
JULY 24TH TO 25TH

Venue: Anna is hosting this next two day ride from Kim and Anne Littleton's property, Johnson Road, Jarrahdale. The ride will be quite scenic in the hills up there but be prepared for the ground being a little hard, take a few more fence poles than normal and make sure your electric fence is charged and turned on, as the fences around the property have been wrecked by the Kangaroos and there are no other stock on the property so gates could be open.

Directions: **From Albany Highway** turn right (from Perth), left (from Albany) into Jarrahdale Road travel through Jarrahdale town and turn right into Nettleton Road, travel along a short way past Jarrahdale Oval and then cross old railway line crossing, take next turn right which is Johnson Road, a gravel road.

If traveling **from the south on South Western Highway**, turn right into Jarrahdale Road at roadhouse and travel up Jarrahdale hill. As you reach Jarrahdale turn left into Nettleton Road, travel along a short way past Jarrahdale Oval and then cross old railway line crossing, take next turn right which is Johnson Road, a gravel road.

If traveling **from Perth on South Western Highway**, turn into Nettleton Road on South end of Byford at Caltex Roadhouse and travel up the hill (approx. 14km) and turn left into Johnson Road.

Once on Johnson Road, cross over old railway line and take next gravel driveway on right, just up the hill and in the bend (less than 1km from Jarrahdale Road). Go through farm gate into paddock straight ahead. Set up camp in this paddock. Water is at far end of paddock in trough.

Times: Saturday start – Pre-ride meeting – 12.30pm. Please ensure you sign Club Ride Register when you arrive and before mounting. 8.30 – 9.00am start Sunday back by lunchtime. Anybody wanting to camp Friday night please let Anna know.

Hay: Clean Hay only please.

Yards: Bring your own – ground could be hard, so bring extra poles.

Water Horse water available, BYO drinking water.

Ablutions: No Toilet or shower

Meals: Bring your own. Fires will be Ok, but bring gas stove in case of wet weather. There is no shelter, so be prepared with Tarps etc if needed.

Children: This event is suitable for children

Tracks: Suitable for Horses and carts. Terrain will be undulating and gravelly with some steeper inclines. Breastplates recommended and horses should be booted or shod.

Fees: Members riding and non riding \$5
Non-members riding and non riding \$25 per day
Late payment on the day add \$5
