

PICKERING BROOK TREK
OCTOBER 28th, 29th and 30th.

NOTE: This is a Friday, Saturday and Sunday Long weekend!

Our next ride will be hosted by Margaret T and Frank on their agistment property at Pickering Brook. The ride will start on **Friday** morning at 1.00pm. Please ensure you arrive well before this time so you can seek out the relevant person and complete all paperwork (Signing Ride register etc) and attend pre-ride meeting before you mount! Saturday's ride will be an all day ride, be prepared to carry your lunch. Sunday will be shorter day to allow people to travel home.

Venue	Margaret Thomas and Frank Pinner's, Pickering Brook
Directions	The property is at 664 Pickering Brook Road, Pickering Brook. From Tonkin Highway turn into Welshpool Road heading toward the hills (Easterly Direction), that is right from the South and Left from the North. Welshpool road runs up into the hills and turns into Pickering Brook Rd well up the top. You will eventually pass Ryan Road on your right. Keep travelling another 300 – 400 meters and the property is the second last one on the right. If you reach the gravel you have gone too far.
Times	Friday ride will commence at 1.00 pm. Arrive about 12:00 midday AT THE LATEST for completing of paperwork and attendance at unmounted pre ride meeting. Saturday will be a 8.30am – 9.00m start and Sunday ride will be a shorter ride, starting at 8.30 – 9:00am. Be prepared to carry your own lunch.
Water	Water available for horses and humans
Hay	Oaten/Wheaten and Lucerne Hay OK. NO meadow hay.
Fires	Fires are OK. Please bring a gas stove in case of bad weather.
Yards	BYO yards, although some may be available, it will be first in best dressed.
Ablutions	Toilet and shower available
Meals	BYO all meals
Tracks	Suitable for horses and carts, although carts may need to take alternate routes, please contact Margaret T on 9257 1949 if you are coming with a cart as soon as possible so she can ensure the rides planned are suitable. Horses preferred shod or wearing boots. The country is undulating with some hills and mainly gravel tracks. Breaching and breastplates recommended.
Children	This event is suitable for children.
