

BYFORD – WUNGONG VALLEY RIDE – 15TH OCTOBER 2011



The Wungong Valley is a beautiful area managed by DEC as the Darling Range Regional Park and horses are permitted in this area. The ride can go up either sides of the valley and the views from the top are stunning. Wildflowers are abundant in this area and the scenery is spectacular

- Venue Darling Range Regional Park, South Western Highway, Byford/Wungong
- Directions **Parking is on the corner of Rails Crescent and South Western Highway, South of Eleventh Road and North of Thomas Road.**
As this parking is right on the highway and area is very limited, please park carefully and make sure your horse is tied securely and attended to at all times. Some floats can enter from the Northern end of Rails Crescent, drive around (as it is a semicircle road) and park along Rails Crescent.

- Times The Ride will commence at 10.00 am, so please arrive no later than 9.30am for a pre ride meeting and briefing.
- Lunch Be prepared to bring your own packed lunch as we will stop up the top for lunch.
- Tracks Not suitable for carts – Sorry! Horses **do need** to be shod or booted for this ride. Tracks will be gravel and steep at times, so breastplates are a must. There will be some creek crossings and the tracks are very rocky at times. Tracks will not be marked so ride will need to keep together.
- Children This event is suitable for children (12 years and over).
- Fees/Forms To Anna Sheehan one week prior to the event with relevant fees.

\$5.00 members - riding/non-riding for whole weekend
\$25.00 **for the day** non members - riding/non-riding (Maximum as a visitor is two days in one year)
\$5.00 extra for late payment on the day.
